ENTRY SPECIFICATIONS

2-D & 3-D media accepted

2-D works must be no larger than 7'(width) x 5'(height)

3-D works must be no larger than 6'x6'x6'

Weight of work shall not exceed 250 lbs.

All entries shall state the artist's sale price.

HJCC's commission for all sales is 40% of the gross sale price.

Artists shall not seek advice from HJCC on sale prices.

There is no theme for this exhibition. All types of artwork are welcome.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Entrants must reside in the State of Hawaii.

Entries must be ready wired for installation.

Works submitted to prior HJCC Art Exhibitions are ineligible for entry.
